1. Library Update.

- The Library will be closed May 23<sup>rd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> for Memorial weekend. The summer schedule will begin May 26<sup>th</sup>, with the Library closing on Saturdays.
- The cement work for the entry way is scheduled to be completed in July. It will be driveway thickness.

2. Library Programs/Classes.

- a. Book Discussion. "Blood and Thunder" will be discussed on June 4<sup>th</sup>.
- b. Family Movie – "Hotel for Dogs" will be presented on May 16<sup>th</sup>.
- c. Teen Program – Movie: "Twilight" will be presented on May 28<sup>th</sup> along with a Pop Pull-Tab Craft activity.
- d. Summer Reading Program. The kick off will be June 12<sup>th</sup> with programs

for all ages. The theme is “Get creative at the Library”. All ages will be encouraged to create a t-shirt. The Library web site lists all of the activities that will be available.

- e. Traveling Teddies. The program will continue from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
