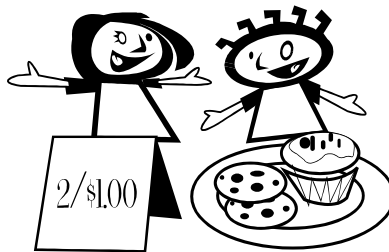
## **James P. Huck, Jr.**

### The Year in Review at the Library

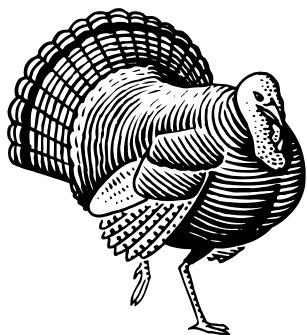
Once again, its time to compile statistics for our annual state aid report. Here is a synopsis of library activity for 2008-09:
